CQ WW CONTEST COMMITTEE - PROPOSED RULES CHANGES -

The CQ WW Contest Committee is pleased to provide a preview of the rules for the 2015 CQ WW DX Contest SSB/CW. This is a public review period to invite any comments before the final rules are announced on June 1, 2015. Proposed changes:

- a.. Minor edits to Overlay Category definition.
- b.. Extended club circle from 175 miles to 200 miles for USA clubs, and from 275 km to 300 km for DX clubs.
- c.. Changed definition of QSO Alerting Assistance. Now if the technology only provides callsign or multiplier information it is considered assistance.
- d.. Remote stations must use a callsign permitted by the authorities at the station location.
 - e.. Top scorers are required to submit logs with accurate frequencies.
- f.. The Observer Program adds the ability for the Committee to request audio recordings of an operation.
